What do we do?

We have been able to organise events such as the Christmas and teddy bear trails; Smarties Challenge; virtual discos as well as the first in person disco for two years; mufti days; sponsored Bunny Bounce; second hand uniform sales and Bag2School collections. Each classroom also received a butterfly garden to learn about the lifecycle of a butterfly and for National Skipping Day, children were presented with a skipping rope to practise their skipping skills. At the end of the summer term, the Year 2 leavers have a special event organised by the PTFA to celebrate their achievements and wish them well on their new adventure as they move on to junior school. It is an exciting fun-filled afternoon for them to relax and enjoy some extra-curricular activities. We are proud to be able to provide funds and enjoyable activities for our school community. All funds raised by the PTFA go directly back to the school whether that is in the form of providing additional school supplies or events for the children and the wider school community.

We also hold monthly meetings, which are open to all parents.






How to get involved
