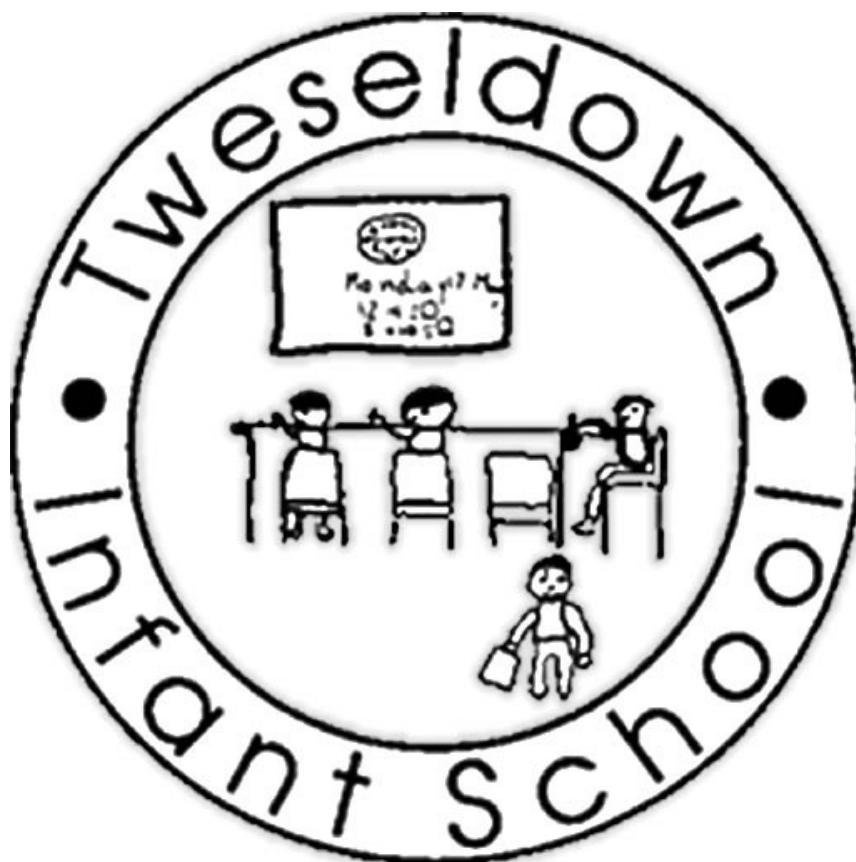

Ensure that my child wears the correct school uniform

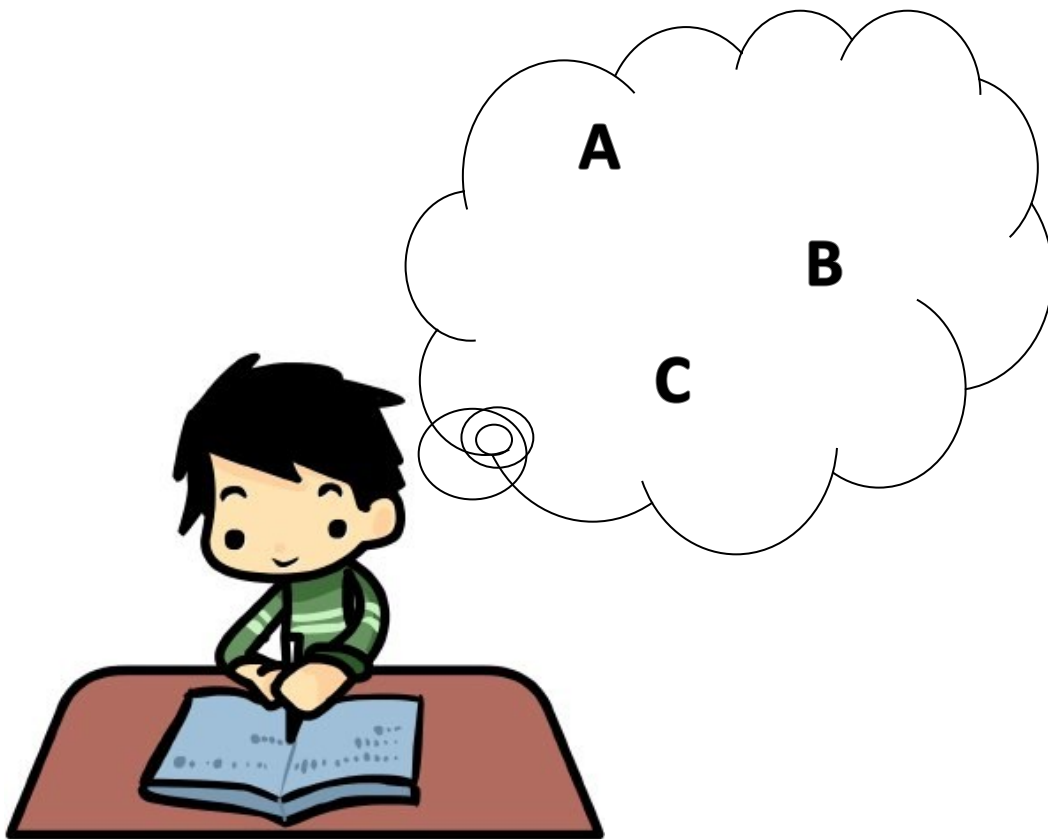
Park appropriately — be respectful to local residents and use designated car parks

Make sure that the school has a progressive School Development Plan in order to maintain and drive high standards

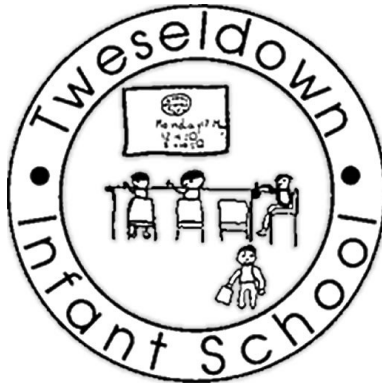
Make sure that pupils are at the heart of all of our decisions to ensure positive outcomes
