



What have we been doing this week?

Year 1 News

This week in Year 1 we have been working hard on our sentence writing. The children have been writing sentences and remembering to start with a capital letter and using these for people's names and places. We have written sentences such as 'I go to Tweseldown School'. Could you practise writing some sentences and thinking about which words need a capital letter?



As part of maths learning, we have been continuing to think about greater than and less than. The children have been learning how to use a number line and comparing numbers identifying which is greater and which is less.



In science we have been learning all about materials. We have walked around the school trying to spot what different items are made of. This week we have been searching for ceramics and plastic. Do you have items made from these materials at home? In RE, we have been sharing our special places and then had a look at a range of different buildings in our local area and tried to think if these were special or not. There were some fantastic responses and explanations.



Next week, it would be great if we had some empty egg boxes. If you have one going in the bin, please could we rescue it and give it a job to help in our maths lessons.


In English we are working towards creating a poster about the seasons and the weather we see in each one. We have identified features and written descriptive sentences about the weather.
