Maths

In Maths, we will continue to develop counting forwards and backwards to and from 100. We will begin to read, write and solve maths statements involving the addition, subtraction and equals symbols. We will do lots of practise around adding single and double digits between 0 and 20 as well as applying this knowledge to different reasoning problems. We will develop our knowledge of numbers bond to 20 and use this knowledge to solve missing number calculations.

PE

In PE, the children will improvise and rehearse dance movements in canon form. We will consider different ways to travel in a dance and begin to perform simple routines.

<u>Music</u>

In music, we will be learning, singing and performing the songs for our Christmas Performance. The children will learn about tempo and dynamics linked to their songs.

Science

In Science, we will focus on the world around us as we learn about seasons. We will start our longitudinal study by choosing an area of the school grounds to visit each half term and to see the changes that occur in this area. We will go outside and identify signs of Autumn and talk about changes that happen as we move into winter. Children will think about this area and how the habitats here may change throughout the different seasons of the year. We will learn about the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees.

History

In History, we will start off with a hook day and experience travelling on an aeroplane, booking a ticket, putting on luggage tags and creating a passport. Over this half term, we will look at how cars have changed over time. Also, we will look at the change in trains from steam power to electric and learn about when the first flight took place. We also have our exciting trip to the Beaulieu Motor Museum where the children will see many modes of transport.

Transport

PHSE and RHE

In RHE, we are going to think about different families and how our friend's families may be different to our own. We will also think about how to keep ourselves safe when we are not at school, especially thinking about stranger danger.

RE

In RE, we will be focussing on special journeys. The children will look at different journeys taken by people in the Nativity before thinking about journeys they have taken with a special ending.

English

In English, we will be enjoying some fantastic texts. We will start off by exploring the One Hundred Decker Bus. The children will use this as inspiration to create their own wonderful mode of transport and will write a description about their idea. We will also write a recount of our exciting trip to Beaulieu and we will share these experiences with other children in the school. We will explore the narrative 'The Naughty Bus' and create our own stories about the Naughty Bus when it visits Tweseldown Infant School. We will continue our focus of writing accurate sentences using accurate capital letters and full stops. We will end this term with some festive Christmas writing! Throughout this half term, we will practise our speaking and listening skills as we rehearse and perform our Christmas Performance 'The Inn-Spectors'.

<u>DT</u>

In DT, we will be developing our sewing skills. We will start off by looking at some different stitches and having a chance to practise these. We will then practise using our stitches to join two pieces of material together. We will use our new skills to produce a lovely Christmas decoration to take home.

Computing

In Computing, the children will develop their word processing skills. They will begin by writing their name, using the shift key to write capitals and learning how to underline, change the colour and bold the text. The children will also learn how to open and save a document.
