

Year R News



This week started with a bang as we began our week of learning about how we celebrate bonfire night. The children helped to draw fireworks with chalk, learned about the importance of firework safety and read a firework poem with rhyming words. They made rockets using junk modelling, created paintings of fireworks with sparkly glitter and created interesting patterns with marbles and paint!



In phonics we have started learning phase 3 sounds. Keep remembering to practise the sounds we have sent home so they are fresh in your child's mind and to work on the oral blending skills to help support their early reading skills. Any questions, speak to your class teacher.



In maths, we have been learning about comparing groups of objects, identifying when there are more/less and have been representing numbers on our fingers. At home, you could practise this more by encouraging your child to identify who has more or less with items around the house. Can they accurately count the items using 1:1 correspondance?

We also learned about Remembrance Day, what it's all about and each child decorated a Poppy to create a class display. Look out for it in classroom windows!

Year 1 trip to Beaulieu



Year 1 News





Back at school, we have been writing about our trip and designing our own version of the 'Hundred Decker Bus'. The children have chosen to put bouncy castles, farms, race cars, parks, gardens and many more different decks on their buses. They have been very imaginative in their ideas! In our maths, we have been identifying one more and one less than a given number. The children have then used their knowledge of number and part, part, whole model and the representing these as a bar model.



The children have started singing songs that are part of the Y1 Christmas Performance and are getting excited to start our rehearsals. Information about costumes will be coming out soon.

Year 2 News



This week, Year 2 have continued their learning in history about castles. This is getting us enthused for our upcoming school trip to Portchester Castle. The children have learnt why castles were built. They learnt about key features of a castle that are used to defend the castle from attackers or intruders. Can your child tell you about the moat, the drawbridge, the keep, the stone walls or any of the weapons that were used to defend a castle?



In art, we are working on making pop art with a repeated motif using printing. We enjoyed choosing different colours and it was fun to use paint!

In English, we have been writing a story based on 'George and the Dragon' by Chris Wormell. The children have impressed us with their descriptive word choices. They have chosen an alternative creature to be George (instead of the mouse in the original story) and it has been wonderful to read their descriptions of this character. We will continue to write this story into next week.



Can your child describe to you what a consecutive number is? We have learnt that consecutive numbers always have a difference of 1. We have been learning what the term 'difference' means in maths and we can describe it using STEM sentences and using the subtraction symbol in number sentences.
