



## Tweseldown Infant School Uniform Policy

### Aims and objectives

Our policy on school uniform is based on the belief that school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in our school
- Helps to create a sense of community and belonging towards the school
- Identifies the children with the school
- Supports our commitment to inclusion
- Prevents children from wearing ‘fashion clothes’ that could be distracting in class
- Is practical, smart and designed with health and safety in mind
- Is considered good value for money by most parents

### Expectations

We expect all pupils to comply with this uniform policy, which will be monitored. Any pupil who falls short of these requirements will be advised of this fact by their class teacher and given the opportunity to improve. Continued failure to comply will be brought to the attention of the Headteacher.

### The Role of Parents

We believe that one of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform and PE kit, and that it is clean, in good repair and that the child’s name is written on all items.

### The Role of Governors

The governing body supports the Headteacher in implementing the School Uniform Policy. It considers all representations from parents regarding the uniform policy and liaises with the Headteacher to ensure that the policy is implemented fairly and with sensitivity. It is the governors’ responsibility to ensure that the school uniform meets all regulations concerning equal opportunities. Item	Optional or Required	Logo or non-logo	Summer or Winter
Blue cardigan or jumper	required	Either a jumper or cardigan with a logo or you are welcome to purchase a plain royal blue jumper or cardigan from any shop.	Can be worn at any time

White Polo Shirt	Required	Either a white polo shirt with a logo however you are welcome to purchase a plain white polo shirt from any shop these normally come in pack of three or five.	Can be worn at any time
Grey Skirts/pinafores/ trousers/skorts	Required	Non-logo	Can be worn at any time
Grey shorts. Blue checked summer dresses	Optional	Non-logo	Can be worn at any time (some people prefer just in the summer months)
Socks	Required in either black/grey or white	Non-logo	Worn every day all year
Blue/Grey/Black Tights	Optional	Non-logo	Can be worn at anytime
Black school shoes	Required	Not trainers	Worn every day all year
Waterproof clothing and wellington boots	Required	Non-logo	Kept in school all year
Coat	Required	Non-logo	Used all year
Book bag (no rucksacks)	Required	Branded (can be purchased second hand from The PTFA)	Used all year
Draw string bag	Required	Non-logo	Used all year for PE kit and waterproof clothing (Some people have two drawstring bags)
PE kit	Required	Non-logo-Plain coloured shorts or jogging trousers and a 'house' coloured T shirt	Used all year
Plain see-through waterbottle	Required	Non-logo	Every day with <b>Non-Fizzy WATER ONLY</b>
