Year R News

What have we been doing this week?

This week Year R have been introduced to some exciting characters; Biff, Chip and Kipper from the Oxford Reading Tree series. We have discovered what their names are, what they do, what they like and who they are related to. This has helped us to talk about ourselves and learn new things about our friends. We had a fun discussion about what different name we call things. We learnt that some people call their brothers and sisters a different name or say part of their body as a different name e.g. an elbow has been called an 'umbow' and a forehead has been called a 'forest'.

In the mornings we have been having Move and Groove sessions to help our core become stronger. We have been practising to tuck our tummies in and squeeze our bottoms together to make us strong, this has helped us to balance and stand on one leg like a stalk. We have also been learning to use our core to help us push off on the floor from lying on our back and on our front.

During our Magic Maths session we have been learning different songs and rhymes to help us count to and back to 10. We have had lots of fun activities in the classroom to help us recognise and order numbers 1 - 5 and then 1 - 10.

During our phonic sessions we have been looking at ways to make different sounds and finding objects that start with the same sounds e.g. having a book and finding a bin because they start with the 'b' sound.



Year 1 News

What have we been doing this week?

This week Year 1 have been performing poetry. We started the week listening to others read poems and watching others perform poems. We now know that we perform with our voices, bodies, hands and facial expressions. Ask us to perform our own penguin poem at home on Friday!

In Maths we have been adding. We represented two numbers with Numicon then combined the amounts to find the total. We have been using the squares in our Maths books to write our own number sentences.

In Geography we have been map detectives. We got given a perspective map of the school and had to figure out which parts of the school we could identify. We toured round the school to help us locate different places.

In Computing this week we used beebots (programmable robots) to move around a map. We had to input clear instructions to make sure they moved in the correct direction.



Year 2 News

What have we been doing this week?

Robin Class and Woodpecker Class have been using iPads to take photos of natural and man-made objects this week. We have been exploring what makes a good photograph and practised taking photographs using our findings. Owl Class and Kingfisher Class have been exploring rhythm and used body percussion and vocals in Music lessons this week.

In Maths this week, we have worked to further our understanding of the value of each digit in a 2-digit number and made 'number posters' to demonstrate all that we know about a number. We have made the numbers using straws, diennes and Numicon to show our understanding that 1 ten is made up of 10 ones. In English, we have told an alien called Blob all of our fab facts about The Great Fire of London. We have learnt to write using the suffix -ed in order to make a verb past tense.

We look forward to seeing your homework houses on Thursday 4th October.
