Monday 29th October – First day back after the half term break.



## Year R News

#### What have we been doing this week?

This week we have been practising our classroom routines and learning how to look after all of the different areas in our learning environment. We have been practising different movements in our classrooms to help strengthen our core muscles. We have been learning to balance on one leg by being a stalk then counting how long we can hold the balance. We have also been practising stepping in and out of hoops while making sure we tuck in our tummies and bottoms.



In our explore and learn time we have continued to explore the outside area and use the continuous provision in our classroom. We have started to learn our names by using different resources to build our names out of. we have made them using magnetic numbers and had a go at writing them on the working wall.









## Year 1 News

#### What have we been doing this week?

This week Year 1 have been writing their own 'Lost and Found' stories. We have had butterflies and bears, coloured crayons and superheroes as some of our Oliver Jeffers inspired characters in our new stories. The children have practised reading their stories to each other before taking them to their old Year R classes to share with the new Year R children.

In Maths the children have been finding one more and one less than a number. Some children were challenged to find two more or less than a number.

During PE the children have been using the five basic gymnastic shapes taught last week to make up their own sequences.

In Art the children have looked at the technique used by Monet in his Water Lilies paintings to try an make their very own versions of the paintings.

### What have we been doing this week?

Did you see the fire engine in the car park on Thursday? We had an enjoyable visit from the fire service! We got to go inside the fire engine and use the fire hose! It was very powerful! We learnt a lot about fire safety and can say a rhyme about keeping safe with matches. Did you know that you should check your smoke alarm once a week?



In Art, we have used paint to create a background for our silhouette pictures of The Great Fire of London. We challenged ourselves to give our silhouettes windows. Planning is underway for our Longitudinal Study in Science and we have begun to make predictions.



We have been counting in tens starting from different numbers; using 100 squares and diennes to help us and we have learnt to identify odd and even numbers. We have learnt to use adverbs and conjunctions in our writing this week in preparation for writing an adventure story.
