

What do I need to supply for YrR?

Uniform & everyday items

	Grey skirt, skorts, pinafore, trousers, blue gingham dress or shorts
	Any style white polo top (Tweseldown logo or plain)
	Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan (Tweseldown logo or plain)
	Appropriate black shoes
	White, black or grey socks or tights
	Appropriate hair wear (no JoJo bows)
	Any style jacket or coat appropriate for the weather (any style gloves, scarfs &/or hat in Winter, as applicable)
	Book bag (Tweseldown logo or other)
	Suitable water bottle
	Spare underwear if necessary
	Any style sun hat Apr-October
	Sun-cream Apr-October

These items should return home daily. There is no lost property. If jumpers are removed, they are put in a box within the classroom & should be collected by the child at the end of the day

Clothing/footwear so your child can enjoy the outdoors in all weathers in a carrier bag

	Waterproof trousers
	Wellies

These items will only return home on the last day of term for washing & checking unless you request them

PE kit

House points are awarded for positive achievements & behaviours. This encourages the children to do well & builds spirit. When your child's house has achieved 1000 points, the children in that house can wear mufti on the next Friday. Children wear their house colour during PE.

The Houses are: Willow = green, Birch = blue, Cherry = red, Oak = white, Chestnut = yellow

Earrings must be removed for PE so please make sure your child can do this independently & safely store them during the lesson

	House coloured T-shirt (can be purchased from Brendas)
	Any appropriate jumper, zip-up or long-sleeve top for colder months
	Navy or black shorts
	Navy or black jogging bottoms or leggings for colder months
	Plimsoles or trainers (no studs)
	Draw-string PE bag (Tweseldown logo or other)

These items will only return home on the last day of term for washing & checking unless you request them

Your child must be able to independently get in & out of any clothing/footwear & apply the suncream you supply

All items including both items of footwear & gloves MUST be named – biro or sharpie or shop-bought labels, regularly check the name is still visible please
