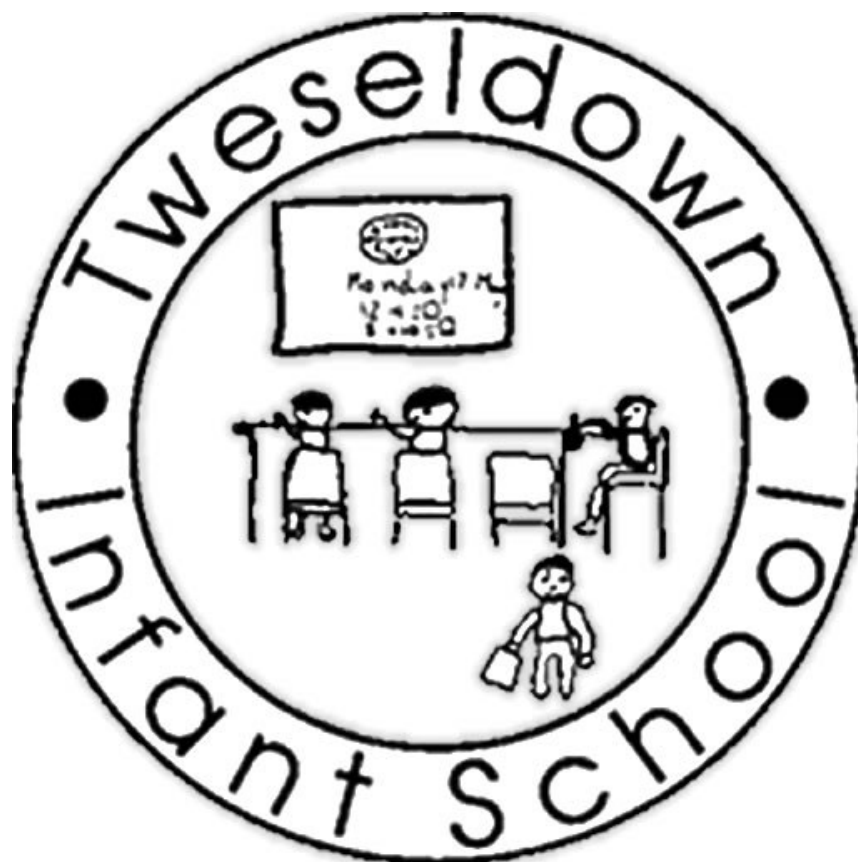

# Home School Agreement 2021-2022

## As a school we will:

Care for your child's safety and happiness.

Encourage your child to reach their full potential at all times

Value your child as an individual.

Provide a curriculum to 'catch up' lost educational time along side meeting the needs of your child's well-being with a focus on school being a fun place to be and learn.

Ensure that we are excellent role models.

Actively encourage good attendance and punctuality.

Ensure that the school's staggered day start and finish times are punctual.

Encourage high standards of behaviour.

Promote high self-esteem ensuring that we listen and respond to your child's concerns.

Keep parents well informed of your child's progress (remotely if need be).

Inform parents ways in which parents can aid their child's educational development.

Ensure that parents are consulted where there are concerns of behavioural/additional needs.

Help support parents with any concerns they may have.

Provide an environment which has been suitably risk assessed in response to the Covid-19 Pandemic.

Adhere to social distancing rules as much as we reasonably can with small children.

Contact parents immediately if your child displays symptoms of Covid-19.

Ensure staff and children do not mix with children from other 'bubbles.'

Inform parents if any child or adult within your child's bubble tests positive for Covid-19 and follow the Government's advice under the 'Track and Trace' program.



**As a parent I will:**

Support the school's aims and values .

Ensure that my child has excellent attendance at school and inform us of reasons why they are not in school on a daily basis

Ensure that my child is collected at the correct staggered time by either myself or a nominated adult during the pandemic

Actively assist my child with homework and home reading.

Encourage my child to always achieve their best.

Support the school with good behaviour.

Attend parent evenings and curriculum events (remotely if required).

Be respectful of the school community and its staff (including on social networking sites).

Keep school updated with any concerns about my child.

Inform school of any changes in my child's home life.

Work with school for the best outcomes for my child.

Make sure that if any contact details change they are given to the school office.

Ensure that my child wears the correct school uniform.

Park appropriately — be respectful to local residents and use designated car parks.

Adhere to the markings around the site regarding social distancing.

Keep my child at home if anyone in the family shows symptoms of Covid-19 and follow Government advice regarding 'Track and Trace'.

Collect my child immediately if asked to do so (if my child is displaying symptoms of Covid-19 and inform school as soon as possible of test results.

Ensure my child arrives and leaves punctually at the staggered time provided by school.

Communicate with school via phone or email (the main office is operating as a virtual office).

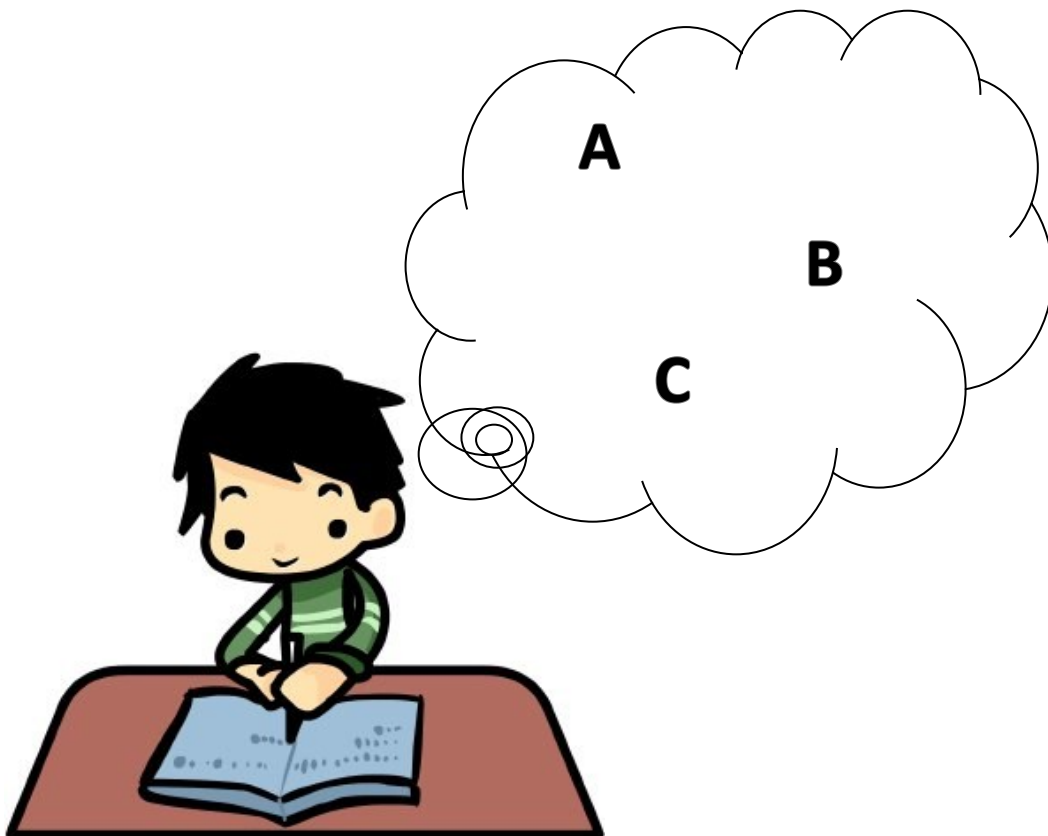
Recognise that if my child is deemed unsafe, they will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe on site.
